Position: Full-Time Public Health Nurse (Long Beach Island Health Department)

Job Description: Promote, maintain, and improve individual and community health by assisting individuals and communities to adopt healthy behaviors as outlined in the Public Health Practice Standards. The Public Health Nurse responds to health questions by individuals and/or families, during home visits, in clinics, in schools or, while giving lectures to community groups to educate the public on preventative health measures. Visits homes of individuals and/or families in the community to gather background information and assess their health needs. Interviews patients and/or families to evaluate health needs or environmental hazard in the homes, such as lead exposure. Implements actions to curtail the spread of communicable diseases. Conducts investigations of suspected disease outbreaks; visits suspected areas and interviews persons who have contracted the disease to compile information on symptoms and environmental factors. Measure patients' temperature, blood pressure, pulse, height, and weight to record patients' vital signs and growth process. Performs related duties as required. Work is performed under the general Direction of a Public Health Nurse Supervisor. Will perform related work as requested by Health Officer.
