GENERAL STATEMENT

The Long Beach Island Health Department is the branch of local government responsible for protecting and promoting the health of the residents of Long Beach Township, Beach Haven, Ship Bottom, Surf City, Harvey Cedars and Barnegat Light.

The Public Health activities and programs include services for individuals and their families, as well as the environment, in which we live, work and play.

SERVICES OFFERED

- **PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING**
Registered nurses provide health promotion services, home visits, and health education.
- **PERI-NATAL PROGRAM**
Registered nurses provide home visits to any pregnant woman to monitor health status, provide education, reinforce peri-natal teaching and familiarize the family with community resources available.
- **VACCINES FOR CHILDREN**
Low cost immunizations for uninsured children up to age 18.
- **LEAD POISONING**
Early detection of childhood lead poisoning (6 months to 5 years old) with access to screening, referral, treatment, and follow-up.
- **SAFE SYRINGE DISPOSAL**
Individuals can safely discard their used syringes for medical waste removal.

• HEALTH EDUCATION

Health Education and Risk Factor Reduction presentation available for Groups, Clubs, Organizations and Businesses.

• ADULT HEALTH PROMOTION

Blood Pressure Screening plus Health Education, Re: Diet, Medication and Risk Factors for Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease, Breast, Cervical and Colon/Rectal Cancer.

• ADULT IMMUNIZATIONS

For Employment, Travel, Routine, and College. Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Tetanus, Pneumonia, Shingles, and Flu.

• COMMUNICABLE DISEASES

Providing for investigation, education and follow-up for prevention of recurrent cases of infectious disease. Mantoux (TB) testing for LBI residents.

• RABIES CONTROL

Free Rabies Vaccination Clinic held each year. Also, investigations and follow-up of animal bites.

• FOOD SURVEILLANCE PROGRAM

Licensed Health Inspectors provide inspections of food service facilities annually.

Additionally, Foodservice Management Courses, plan reviews and consultations are conducted throughout the year.

• RECREATIONAL BATHING PROGRAM

Our Bathing Program provides inspections of Public Swimming Pools and bathing places for supervision, safety, equipment, and maintenance. Additionally, a cooperative program providing for sampling and laboratory analysis of recreational Ocean and Bay waters is conducted routinely during the summer season.

• ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLAINTS

Complaints regarding weeds, poison ivy, trash and debris, insect, rodent and housing complaints are investigated and processed according to applicable property maintenance laws.
