COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

Until the vaccine can be produced in large quantities it is expected that it will first be given to priority groups of people – considered critical populations - who have been identified at high risk of COVID-19.

Currently, Covid-19 vaccines are available to those who are in Category 1A which includes paid and unpaid persons serving in health care settings who have the potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients or infectious materials and long-term care residents and staff.

Once vaccine availability expands, essential workers, which fall into Category 1B, will be able to get vaccinated.

The next category of individuals, Category 1C, are adults 65 and over and adults with underlying medical conditions.

After these phases are complete, the general public will be eligible for vaccination.

At this moment, the Long Beach Island Health Department does not have Covid-19 vaccine and is not scheduling appointments or offering a waiting list. When the vaccine becomes available to our LBI residents we will release an announcement.
