The Long Beach Island Health Department has received an allotment of single dose Johnson and Johnson Janssen Covid-19 Vaccine

As eligibility continues to expand, we want to ensure those remaining most at risk of severe illness due to Covid-19 have an opportunity to receive a vaccine.

With this single dose vaccine we are hosting separate clinics for the Ocean County's population 65 and over, 18 and over with any medical condition(s) that put them at risk for severe illness and/or physical condition that makes it difficult to get out to a clinic for a two-dose series. We will be posting appointments as supply permits on this tab the week of April 4th.
