Long Beach Island Health Department Offers Pfizer Covid-19 Immunization Booster

LBIHD is providing the Pfizer Covid-19 Booster and 3rd Doses at St. Francis Parish Hall by appointment only. As we begin the booster campaign, we also want to continue to encourage individuals to receive the primary series. Those unvaccinated remain vulnerable and are driving a significant portion of new cases resulting in severe outcomes and hospitalizations.

The Schedule & Information is As Follows:

Who: For those who have received Pfizer initially, a booster dose is to be administered no sooner than six months after the date of your completed series specifically for:

- Individuals 65 years of age and older;
- Residents of long-term care settings;
- Individuals aged 18 through 64 with [underlying medical conditions](#);
- Individuals aged 18 through 64 years who are at increased risk for Covid-19 exposure and transmission because of occupational or institutional setting.

What: The U.S. FDA amended the [emergency use authorization](#) (EUA) for the Pfizer-BioNTech Covid-19 booster doses.

When: Starting Tuesday Starting October 5th From 9-12pm Pfizer Booster & 3rd dose by **Appointment Only**, to schedule visit <https://lbihealth.com/pfizer-covid-19-vaccine-booster-shot/> , or call 609-492-1212.

Where: St. Francis Parish Hall, 4700 Long Beach Boulevard, Brant Beach, NJ 08008.

Note: Please remember to bring one copy of any completed forms, your Covid-19 Vaccination Record Card, and a facial covering.
