LBIHD Continues to Offer Covid-19 Immunizations for All Ages at their Office and has Partnered with Local Municipalities to Expand Covid Vaccination Locations & Convenience

Long Beach Island Health Department (LBIHD) continues to offer Covid-19 Vaccines weekly at our Ship Bottom office on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Whether you wish to receive your first, second, additional, or booster dose, all Covid-19 vaccine manufacturers (Moderns, Pfizer, and Janssen) are available in the comfort of our office and clinic space as follows:

Where: LBIHD 2119 Long Beach Boulevard, First Floor, Ship Bottom, 08008 (Across from Joey's Pizza)

When: Every Tuesday, 1:30 - 3:15pm (Pediatric Clinic ages 5-11)
Every Wednesday, 9am – 3pm (Ages 12+) Walk-Ins are Welcome

Additionally, LBIHD has partnered with island municipalities to provide a convenient opportunity for the residents of Long Beach Island to receive the Covid Vaccine in the town in which they live or live nearby.

The Schedule is as Follows:

Tuesdays from 10:00am – 11:30am

March 8 – Long Beach Township Court Room (6805 Long Beach Boulevard Brant Beach, NJ 08008)

March 15– Harvey Cedars Borough Meeting Room (7606 Long Beach Blvd., Harvey Cedars, NJ 08008)

March 22 – Beach Haven Borough Meeting Room (300 Engleside Ave, Beach Haven, NJ 08008)

Appointments are recommended, but LBIHD will also accommodate walk-ins. Individuals under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Note, the clinics above are for individuals aged 12 and up.
